Autism is a baffling condition, first “discovered” over half a century ago. Sadly what is known about this often misunderstood condition still remains breathtakingly scant. There is no blood test, brain scan or urine sample to detect its presence. No-one knows what causes it or why it happens, or indeed how many people have it – all we do know is that it is a lifelong condition, which is as yet incurable. In rural Northumberland, The Toby Henderson Trust is leading the way for families and carers to access the support and practical services their children so desperately need.

We officially opened our doors on 1st November 2001 to offer a comprehensive range of services to its growing number of users. We work both intensively with the children themselves on a one to one basis and support their families and carers in identifying practical strategies to help their children reach their true potential. We celebrate their individuality, harness their motivations and teach through the medium of play. We have latterly extended our range of services to incorporate support services for the growing number of young adults receiving a later diagnosis. Current services include:
